Russian Government Scholarship

Russian higher educational institutions offer studies in the Russian and English languages depending on the chosen programme. Programmes taught in the Russian language require a one year preparatory course related to the field of study included in the scholarship.

The Department will also consider applications from existing Russian Government Scholarship holders who would like to apply for DHET scholarship support. Please note that existing scholarship holders will also have to meet the minimum eligibility requirements as stated below in order to be considered for DHET support.



Who Can Apply

- South African Citizens, who have graduated from Secondary School and TVET College and wish to study for a Bachelor's Degree
- South African Citizens, who have graduated from University with a Bachelor's Degree and wish to study for a Master's Degree
- South African Citizens, who have graduated from University with a Master's Degree and wish to study for a PhD
- Please note medical studies and related medical fields will not be covered under this scholarship programme

Russian Government Scholarship

The Russian Government Scholarship COVERS:

- free tuition for the entire duration of the chosen programme
- maintenance allowance (50\$ per month)
- access to dormitory accommodation (if available)



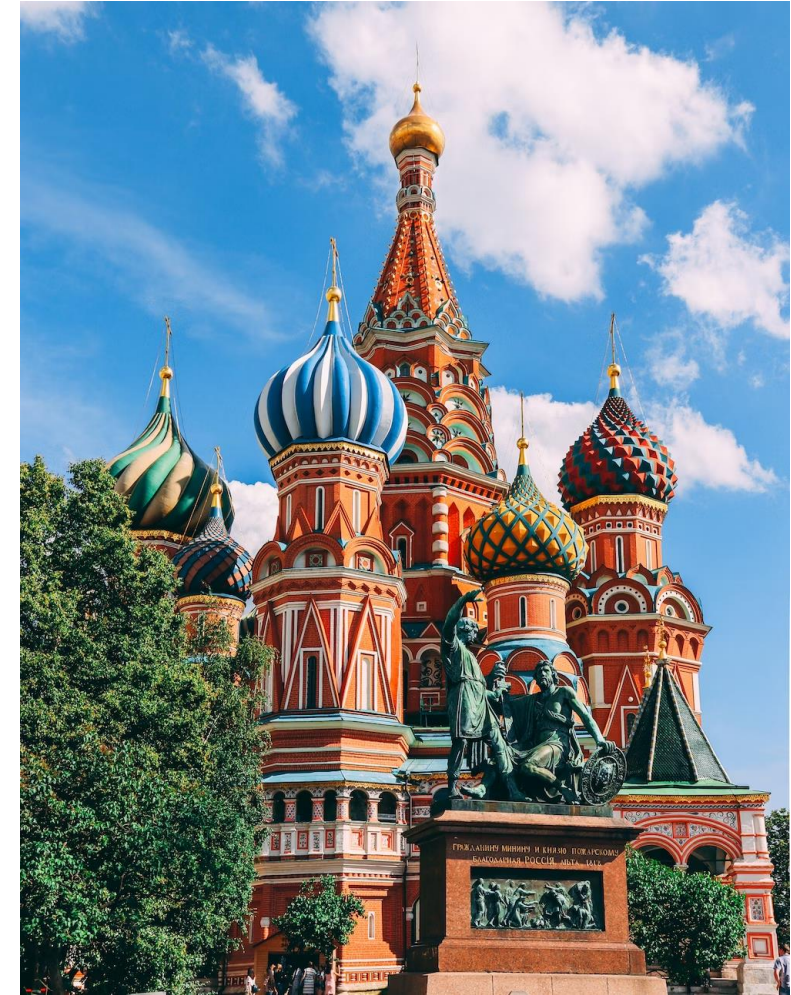

Russian Government Scholarship

DHET COVERS:

- travel costs
- a monthly stipend
- a once-off settlement allowance
- an annual allowance payable at the beginning of each academic year
- visa costs
- pre-departure and on scholarship student support



How To Apply

- Two-part application process
- Complete BOTH the DHET application form and start the Russian Government online application on <https://education-in-russia.com/>
- Submit the DHET application form with supporting documents listed below to russiaapplications@dhet.gov.za by 1 February 2024.
 - Use the subject line: Russian Scholarship Application, [Your surname]

How To Apply

NEW APPLICANTS:

- Candidates are expected to complete the application form online on the website <https://education-in-russia.com/> by 1 FEBRUARY 2024.
- The applicant is required to choose a university and education programme they would like to pursue.
- Only applicants who complete the application can be considered for the nomination process and scholarship support.

RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

- If you are an existing Russian Government Scholarship holder and you would like to apply for the DHET support, please submit the DHET application form with supporting documents listed below to russiaapplications@dhet.gov.za by 1 February 2024.

Minimum Requirements for DHET Scholarship

- South African citizens in good health;
- Have a strong academic record:
- Bachelor's applicants require a minimum average of 70% in their NSC (excluding Life Orientation);
- Postgraduate applications should have performed well in their previous studies with a minimum 65% average mark achieved in their previous studies;
- Meet the minimum academic requirement for entry into a similar programme at a Russian university
- Available and eligible to study in Russia from September 2024;
- Meet the entry criteria for their selected programme in Russia;
- An interest in studying in Russia and demonstrated commitment to the development of South Africa;

Supporting Documentation

- Application Form
- Passport Home Page
- National Senior Certificate with Bachelor's Pass
- Bachelor's Degree Certificate and complete transcripts
- Honour's Degree Certificate and complete transcripts
- Master's Degree Certificate and complete transcripts
- Study Plan or Research Proposal for postgraduate applications

Contracts and Obligations

- All scholarship recipients must sign the contract with the DHET
- Distinction between offer from Host Country and support from DHET
- DHET provides supplementary support
- Return to South Africa upon completion of studies
- Adhere to Guidelines and Code of Conduct
- Successfully complete your studies within the time allocated
