I. Introduction

To cultivate cross-disciplinary thinking on medicine and humanity, NKNU provides medicine and humanity online course. The courses will cover issues including: medical literature and cultural trends, medical humanities and narrative medicine, medical humanities and child care, aging writing and disability, health care and humanities. Through the courses, students are expected to advance their understanding of medicine and humanity and develop critical thinking on cross-border, cross-disciplinary topics.

A. Course Objectives

The course aim to cultivate the following skills:

1. To identify cross-border issues in medicine and humanity
2. To analyze medicine and health-related issues in literature
3. To exercise critical thinking on interaction between medicine and humanity

B. Course Content

1. Cross-disciplinary thinking on literature, politics and medical culture
2. Cross-cultural and cross-border interaction on medicine and humanity
3. Communication and reflection on medicine and humanity
4. Understanding of medicine, health care and humanity
5. Comparing the development and practice of modern medicine East and West

II. Quota

Open enrollment for 30 participants (priority will go to person with recommendations from teachers.)

The course is ideal for:

1. African Citizenship with High School or Higher Education
2. Educators, School Staff, Students or Government Officials
3. Africans residing in other countries are welcomed.

B. Course Delivery

1. 24-hour Online Courses: Online/live via Google Meet using EMI teaching providing topic course sharing, comprehensive discussion, task feedback and guide participants to conduct self-exploration courses.
2. 12-hour Self-review: Online self-review including assignments, watching videos, problem solving, group work and other tasks to be completed. With additional resources available, either individually or in groups, participants can work at their own pace.
3. 4-hour Counseling: Course introduction and participants will have individual counseling with mentor.
4. 10-hour Assessment: Course reflection records, presentations and evaluation

- A. Admission Announcement: May 2023, Taiwan time
Official notification of acceptance will be sent by email to successful applicants.
- B. Admission Criteria: Priority will be given to applicant who meet the qualifications and have passion for Mandarin.
